### BBQ COSTS

The following produce will be available for the BBQ each week.

21kg sausages @ \$11.90 per kg	\$249.90
25kg bacon @ \$12.80 per kg	\$320.00
7.5kg onions @ \$5.80 per kg	\$ 43.50
25 dozen eggs @ \$4.50 per dozen	\$112.50
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>\$725.90</b>

### SUPPLIES

The Association is responsible for the provision of the following items:

- Ordering produce for delivery and having produce available on the allocated BBQ date
- Supply of serviettes, sauce, oil and foil
- Supply cooking utensils
- **REPRESENTATIVE TEAMS ONLY:** Provide a float
- Create price list for the season and provide laminated copies of same
- On request, access to the Association's EFTPOS machine

Clubs and Teams are responsible for the provision of the following items:

- Purchase bread rolls. Suggested purchase; 250 long rolls and 250 round rolls
- **CLUBS ONLY:** Provide a float
- Supply trays for cooked produce
- Supply gloves for personnel cooking and serving
- BBQ set up and clean up
- Fill all gas bottles used at the end of the day. Any gas bottles not filled will incur \$100.00 fee

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Clubs and Teams are permitted to sell cakes at the same time as their allocated BBQ, however may only sell from the BBQ site. No items sold shall conflict with items sold in the canteen.
- In the event of wet weather and cancellation of BBQ, the Club and Teams will be offered any existing vacancy on the BBQ Roster.
- **REPRESENTATIVE TEAMS ONLY:** BBQ is a requirement for all representative teams and development squads and cannot be removed from the roster.
- Any changes required to the produce list are required to the Vice President at least one week prior to the allocated BBQ date.



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- It is recommended teams begin setting up between 7:00am – 7:30am ready for the first game, commencing at 8:30am.
- Children and young people aged 16 years and under are not to be near or around the BBQ at any time.

### CANTEEN

- Clubs and Teams are required to staff the canteen from 8:00am – 3:15pm on their allocated days.
- Each Club and Team shall allocate at least three (3) personnel to the canteen at any one time to assist the Canteen Supervisor. Failure to do so will incur a fine.
- Clubs and Teams with shared duties are required to liaise with each other to ensure sufficient coverage, based on their availability.
- The Canteen Supervisor will delegate responsibilities to all personnel while they are assisting in the canteen.

### DUTY

- Clubs and Teams are required to commence duties from 8:00am – 4:00pm on their allocated days.
- Each Club and Team shall allocate at least two (2) personnel to the Control Room at any one time to assist the Executive Committee. Failure to do so will incur a fine.
- Clubs with 15 or more teams are allocated two (2) duties, while teams with 8 (eight) teams or less have been given shared duties.
- Personnel must be 15 years of age or older to undertake required duties.
- Duties include:
  - o Putting out and collecting bins
  - o Filling ice bags
  - o Provide and collect spare bibs as requested
  - o Confirm the availability of first aid supplies used, provide as requested and advise if replacements are required
  - o Making announcements as requested
  - o Distributing, collecting and sorting score sheets
  - o Timing of games
  - o Entering scores to PlayHQ
  - o Return any unused goal post covers
  - o Alert Executive Members to any game day concerns



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- Any other reasonable request by an Executive Member
